



## Dress Code

Take a moment to read our Dress Code Policy which applies to members and guests of the Wisconsin Club.

### Clubhouse Attire

Appropriate attire for all dining areas:

- Collared shirts and mock collar shirts, with sleeves
- Turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks
- Sweaters
- Casual or dress slacks
- Casual or dress skirts or dresses at an appropriate length
- Jeans - tailored and worn appropriately
- Shorts - at an appropriate length
- Sports fan attire

Jackets, sport coats, and ties are required at specific private functions and member events.

Please - no hats or caps, sandals or flip flops, athletic attire, t-shirts or jackets with inappropriate or offensive printing/graphics

### What to Wear on the Golf Course

The Club enforces a dress code for the golf course and practice range, with no exceptions. Members and guests will use the appropriate locker room to change footwear and attire. Please do not change in the parking lot.

#### Appropriate Men's attire:

- Collared shirts and mock collar golf shirts with sleeves
- Turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks
- Sweaters
- Jackets
- Traditional (shoe top) tailored length trousers
- Plus Fours (Knickers)
- Golf Shorts (no more than 2" above the knee)

#### Appropriate Ladies attire:

- Collared shirts and crew shirts with or without sleeves
- Turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks
- Sweaters
- Jackets
- Slacks
- Sport Dresses, Skirts, Culottes, Golf Shorts (no more than 4" above the knee)
- Plus Fours (Knickers)
- Tights - only under skirts or golf shorts

Metal or ceramic spiked golf shoes are not permitted. Shirts should be tucked in, except those with finished hems designed to be worn loose. All hats must be worn forward.
